Did you know that in Ballarat...

- About one in five Ballarat children starting school are considered developmentally vulnerable (lowest 10% in the state) in at least one of five areas tested, such as physical health, social competence, emotional maturity, language skills and communication skills. *
- Approximately 30% of Ballarat households have a total income of less than \$600 per week.*
- There are over 230 applications for Early Housing placements in Ballarat; for people who are experiencing or at risk of recurring homelessness, people with a disability who have significant support needs, and people with special housing needs. **

With generous WPG donations, last year we...

- Helped to provide 23,020 meals through the programs we fund
- Put 4107 books in the hands of Ballarat children
- Supported 5864 people, both directly and indirectly through the programs we fund
